



ELSO Train the Trainers (TTT) course

ELSO TTT course was conducted in Barcelona on October 12-14th this year. It is a comprehensive simulation-based learning educational program for ECMO educators from all over the world, with the objective to enhance the educational skills of ECMO educators. The course is run by international ELSO experts from all ELSO chapters. A total of 36 Participants attended the course with 12 faculty members (Ratio 1:3).
